If you would like to get creative in the **New Year** I am offering some courses

Making Pots!

In this course you will learn how to make a range of ceramic vessels using several techniques

- throwing on the potter's wheel
- coil pot construction
- pinch pots
- slab pots

You will also learn how to attach handles, decorate, turn and glaze your work

This is a 4 week course with classes running from 7 - 8.30pm on a week night (Monday, Tuesday or Wednesday). Classes start from 11th January

The course cost £120 per person and is limited to 3 people per class (this price includes all materials)

Taster Throwing Masterclass

This a 1-hour lesson on how to make pots using a pottery wheel. Suitable for beginners and those with some experience.

£60 one to one

£30 per person for two people (materials and firing included)
